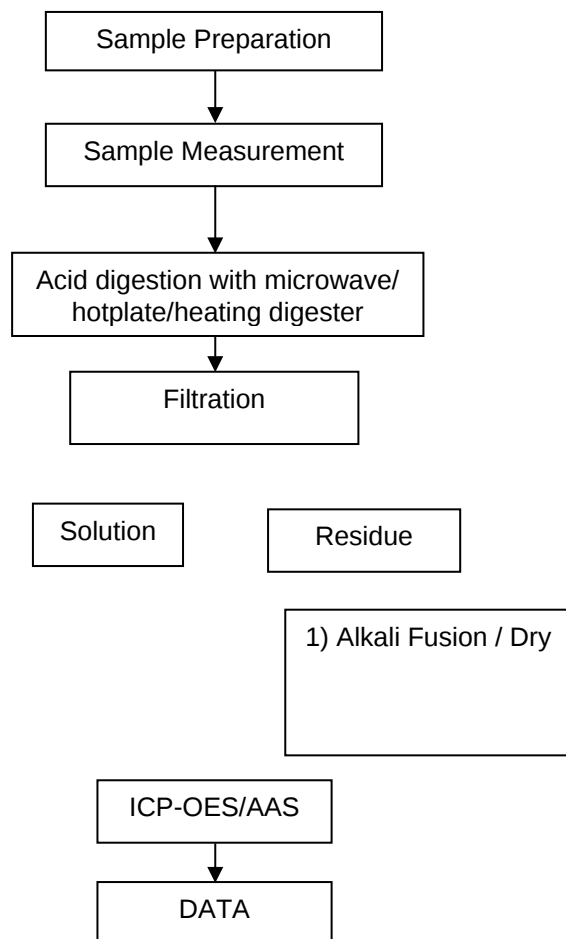

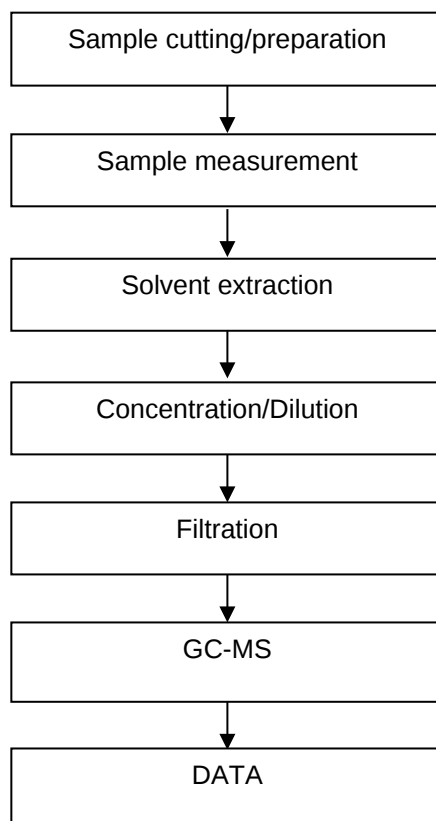
**Elements Testing Flow Chart**
